50% refund is given if you cancel less than 7 days prior to first class. (We can also transfer you in the same class at a different date/time) Group lessons usually need to have 4 or more students in the class. If less than 4 students sign up, students can: Transfer to another class of equal dollar value, get a full refund, or have the class with fewer sessions.
