**All Leagues ORIENTATION CLINIC Monday June 7, Open House Time: 5:30pm – 8pm at Highland Driving Range** (Juniors can show up anytime from 5:30pm - 8pm) League Orientation is at Highland National Driving Range (If poor weather orientation will be at Highland Clubhouse) Attendance is mandatory for all players. At Orientation:

- Juniors will receive permanent tee-time
- Golf Etiquette Quiz and League Rules Reminders
- Free Range Balls (Range stalls reserved to practice hitting balls for Juniors, may have to share/wait at certain times)
- Free Golf Balls to juniors for use on the course during the league, also have a free limited supply of head covers
- Guess Tee's Contest Prizes (Golf Equipment and Movie passes)
- Buy New sets of Junior Clubs (First Tee will have a limited number of junior sets \$75 includes bag, as well as some used clubs)



### **5 Hole Cub League (Ages 6-10) \$85**

**Session #L 21-A**

A great league for juniors who are not ready for 9 holes yet. This league will also take less time to complete. Each week juniors will play on the Highland 9 Golf Course, (1797 Edgcumbe Rd) west side of Montreal Avenue and will have the option to either play from the front tees or from special tee markers positioned to help shorten the longer holes. Players will compete and receive prizes for on course contests.

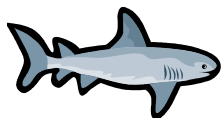
**DATES: Monday June 14, 21, 28 July 12, 19\*, 26, Aug 2, 9** Rainout: August 16



**TEE-TIMES: Between 10:30-11:30 AM.** You will receive a permanent tee-time for the summer.

**TO HELP DETERMINE PICK-UP TIME:** Add about 1 hour 15 minutes from tee-time to play 5 holes. *For example, if a junior has a tee-time at 11:00 AM they should be done by around 12:15 PM.*

### **OPTION #1: Great White Shark: Session #L22-A**

**Where: Highland National Golf Course, (1403 Montreal Ave)** Each week juniors will rotate between playing the front nine holes (1-9) and back nine (10-18)

**TEE-TIMES: Between 7:00 AM and 8:45 AM.** You will receive a permanent tee-time for the summer. *\*all players need to be finished with 9 holes by 11am due to outside golf tournaments*



## **OPTION #2: Hammerhead Shark:**

**Session #L22-B**

**Where:** Highland 9 Golf Course, (1797 Edgcumbe Rd) Play 9 holes of golf

**TEE-TIMES:** Between **9:10-10:45 AM**. You will receive a permanent tee-time for the summer  
*\*TBD In July or August, The Hammerhead League will get a chance to play 9 holes at Highland National Course(1403 Montreal Ave)*



**TO HELP DETERMINE PICK-UP TIME:** Add about 2 hours 10 minutes from tee-time to play 9 holes. For example, if a junior has a tee-time at 10:00 AM they should be done by around 12:10 PM.



## **9 Hole Annika League (Ages 7-14) \$110**

**Third year we have a league just for girls!** Now girls have an opportunity to learn, compete, and play 9 holes with each other. The **Annika League will play 9 holes on Highland 9 Hole Course and The Highland National 18 Hole Golf Course.** They will play the back or the front nine based on the course's decision for that week.

## **OPTION #1: Annika at Highland National**

**Session #L23-C**

**Where:** Highland National Golf Course, (1403 Montreal Ave) Each week juniors will rotate between playing the front nine holes (1-9) and back nine (10-18)

**TEE-TIMES:** Between **7:00 AM and 8:45 AM**.

*\*all players need to be finished with 9 holes by 11am due to outside golf tournaments*



## **OPTION #2: Annika at Highland Nine**

**Session #L23-D**

**Where:** Highland 9 Golf Course, (1797 Edgcumbe Rd) Play 9 holes of golf

**TEE-TIMES:** Between **9:20-11:00 AM**. You will receive a permanent tee-time for the summer.

*\*July 6 and one of the last two weeks( In August) The Hammerhead League will play Highland National Course(1403 Montreal Ave)*



**TO HELP DETERMINE PICK-UP TIME:** Add about 2 hours 10 minutes from tee-time to play 9 holes. For example, if a junior has a tee-time at 10:00 AM they should be done by around 12:10 PM.



## **18 Hole Tuesday League (Ages 10-16) \$140 Session #24L-D**

**Where:** The 18 Hole Tuesday League will play each week on Highland National Golf Course. Juniors will be assigned one tee-time for the whole summer. Each week they will play the course, compete in on-course contests and win various prizes.

**DATES:** Tuesday's June 15, 22, 29, July 13, 27, Aug 3, 10, 17

*\*No League July 20 due to another tournament*



**TEE-TIMES:** Between 8:00-9:00 AM. You will receive a permanent tee-time for the summer.

**TO HELP DETERMINE PICK-UP TIME:** Add about 4 hours from tee-time to play 18 holes. For example, if a junior has a tee-time at 8:00 AM they should be done by around 12:00 PM.



## PLAYer League \$80 (Ages 9 -11, 12-15)

Franco Zerna will be the lead instructor on most PLAYer Leagues.

Juniors will spend time practicing on the range as well as taking their golf game to the golf course. The class includes instruction, multiple green

fees at Highland 9 Hole Course or Highland National Golf Course, prizes, range practice, and snack. (Most rounds will be at the Highland 9 Hole Course) Golf training covers putting, chipping, pitching, grip, stance, ball position, posture, pivot, weight shift, woods & irons full swing, course management, and basic rules/etiquette. Juniors can play the course with friends, groups will be determined by age & playing ability.

## **Junior League Rules:**

### **Code of Conduct**

- Have Fun, build friendships, and improve your golf game
- Be safe (Look behind and in front of you before swinging) Yell, "FORE!" if you think your golf ball in the air, may hit someone.
- Respect others (Bullying is not acceptable)
- Respect the golf course and clubhouse (Repair ball marks, fix your divots, & rake bunkers. Be courteous and polite to staff, starters and rangers.) Club throwing, cheating, littering, & swearing are not acceptable and grounds for removal from league.

### **Pace of Play**

- Keep pace with the group in front of you.
- Rangers/staff will be on the course to help you
- Be ready to play your ball. No one should need to wait for you to get ready to play. You should be ready to play when it is your turn.
- Take no more than a couple minutes to look for a lost ball
- Always leave clubs at the back or side of the Green closest to the next tee.

### **Tee-Markers**

- Play appropriate markers to have more Fun (General guidelines)

### **Heavy rains/lighting**

- Staff can post on the internet call Highland National 651-695-3774 (30 minutes before Tee-time) or call Franco (651) 315-5266 to see if cancelled.
- Light rain will not cancel league.

### **Etiquette & Rules**

- Please be quiet when another person is hitting
- Don't walk on another persons putting line, & when you play in a sand trap, rake your footprints
- Be a good golf partner, speaking politely and using kind remarks to comment on another's game are always appreciated.
- No swearing or club throwing
- Be respectful to each other. Notify staff if you are being harassed, teased, or feel uncomfortable in any way!
- Always stand behind the person hitting, at a safe distance.
- One warning for behavioral problems, you will be asked to leave the league and there will be no refunds if you have to be warned twice.

### **Safety**

- Before you swing, make certain there is no one standing close and that your shot is clear.
- Stand a safe distance from someone who is about to swing.

These rules will be covered at the Orientation Clinic and expected to be followed during the league.
